Update on Home Rule Petition... Bob reached out to Jennifer Flannigans office, Chair of Children and Welfare Committee. Her committee supported with a favorable vote on May 25th, passing it onto the Steering Committee. We're hearing that the Steering Committee was also favorable and should be attached to legislation within a week. We'll need to reach out to as many democrats as we can to get them on board to push this through before the end of session (June 30<sup>th</sup>). Otherwise we'll be waiting till January. Bob will reach out to Ed Hurley of YMCA to see if he has any contacts in legislature to help the push.

Bob did speak with Bill Keegan, he has a lot on his plate, and is hoping the intern (11 hours per week) will be able to help. We need to discuss with Rec about the current process and if they're able to keep record of trained individuals. There should be two databases, one by the Town Hall for town workers and one by the Rec for folks other than school volunteers.

Lynda gave the letter to child care providers and it was approved to be sent out.

Lynda gave out drafts of the postcard we'd like to pass out to leaders of groups as a hand out to folks who have taken the D2L training as an update.

Bob would like to meet again before the end of the month to encourage folks to reach out to any senate members to support Bill#H4912, our home rule petition.
