On behalf of our client, G. Greene Properties, LLC, we are submitting herewith a Notice of Intent pursuant to Chapter 131, S.40, Wetlands Protection Act (WPA) and Article 267 of the General Bylaws of the Town of Foxborough for the modification of landscaping/grading, additional parking and additional outside storage for the existing facility that lies partially within the buffer zone of a bordering vegetated wetland.

Enclosed please find 8 copies of the Notice of Intent, which includes the site plans prepared by this office. All abutting owners within 100' of the property have been notified about the proposed work by certified mail. A check in the amount of \$537.50 based on the WPA fee of \$1,050 and a check in the amount of \$1,500 based on the local bylaw are enclosed.

The existing site consists of a 2.63 acres parcel of land that lies on the south side of Spring Brook Road adjacent to Spring Brook (Appendix A). The site was constructed in 1994 under an Order of Conditions (SE 157-244) issued by the Commission on July 11,1994. In March, 2020 the current owner filed a RFDA and the Commission issued a positive determination to require the filing of a Notice of Intent (NOI) for the work done and proposed. The bordering vegetated wetlands shown under the original permit are on this plan. Our investigation determined that Spring Brook is not shown on the latest USGS map and we have determined through Streamstats that the drainage basin is 0.14 square miles. Therefore, under 314 CMR 10.58(2)1(c)i the stream does not meet the definition of a perennial stream.

The Owner has undertaken work on the site in areas within the jurisdiction of the Commission. Specifically, he has increased the paved parking area on the east side of the building and created gravel storage areas on the south side of the building. He has also cleared land to the south of the building. An erosion control barrier consisting of a silt sock and silt fencing has been installed around the site to the south and west of the building. Most of the fence is located outside of the Commission's 25' No-Disturb Zone (NDZ), though it should be noted that the site was built prior to the adoption of that local bylaw.

The purpose of this NOI is to present mitigation measures in the area of storm water management, to ensure that no further work is done in the NDZ, and to restore the buffer zone. There is a natural low area to the

southwest and south of the building where we are proposing a storm water basin that will capture runoff from a portion of the parking areas and building. The existing grades will not be changed but a 1'-3' high stone wall will be constructed generally along the NDZ from on-site materials that will create a berm of the basin and will also act to prevent future movement into the NDZ. The remainder the disturbed area south and west of the building will be seeded with a New England Erosion Control/Restoration Mix for Detention Basins & Moist Sites.

The general sequence of activities would be as follows:

- Construct walls
- Seed disturbed areas

No materials will be imported to the site. We expect to use the existing boulders on the property. Erosion control will be handled through the use of the existing silt fence and siltation socks that will be maintained until the project has been completed and ground cover has been reestablished. No work is proposed within BVW or within the NDZ except for seeding of disturbed areas in the NDZ. Further, no work is proposed outside of areas that are already disturbed.


