CIP Meeting

Police Chief came before the Committee to get approval to purchase a new cruiser for the Canine Unit. Would be a purchase of just over \$43,000. That includes all the set up for the vehicle. The Chief indicated that this vehicle has typically been a hand me down vehicle for years but that since the new vehicles, other than the Crown Victoria's, that they were smaller and less accommodating for the Officer and the Canine. The new Police Interceptors are more suitable as they are a form of SUV and this would make this vehicle useful on many fronts.

Roger made a motion to approve a vehicle for this use- A Police Interceptor in the amount of up to \$43,500 funded with Police Vehicle Apparatus Revolving Funds. Seconded by Deb Spinelli. All voted in favor.

The Chief will provide the Town Manager with a document for this purchase that I can approve.
