7 p.m. Paul I. We'll begin with Article 17 – Citizens Petition for sidewalk on South Street DP – Reviews email discussion with Town Moderator Frank Spillane. Opens up for questions. Frank Spillane – Provides clarity on questions surrounding the costs associated with the warrant article. And that the final motion should clarify the funding source prior to Town Meeting. Chris Gallagher – Describes his own review of the potential sidewalk. Estimates the cost will be between 250-500 thousand dollars. Reviews the Complete Streets plan with the AdCom.

Jack M.- Explain how this stretch and some even more hazardous areas are not on the plan? CG – The plan is created in conjunction with the state and is focused on roads around schools. That safety is where the priority is. Jay M. Is the pavement plan, sidewalk plan, and ADA plan made available to the public? CG Yes, in anticipation of these question they have all been posted. MB Was this proposed sidewalk addition considered when the sidewalk plan was put together? Jay M When is the list reviewed? Does it expire? CG. Yes, the Complete Streets plan has language for periodic review, but the time frame is not specific.

ADCOM Discusses pros/cons of article including safety, prioritization, outreach, and the review of the complete streets plan. **Motion:** Motion made to approve Article 17 as written, motion seconded, motion defeated 3-6 vote.

Paul I - Moving on to the Billboard Warrant Article #28

Frank S. Nothing has changed since the last time we presented. Reviews display boards with AdCom. Review of the distances surrounding the billboards and locations. No new comments from AdCom. **Motion:** Motion made to approve warrant article as written, seconded, motion passes unanimously.

Paul I – Next item on the agenda is Article #9 OPEB appropriation. We have approved the article as it stands, based on the email received from Town Finance is there any further action or discussion required?

Jack M. Based on the email, it does not appear that a reduction of 200K will negatively impact on the ratings. **AdCom** discussion on where money would be reappropriated to. **Motion**: Motion made to reduce article 9 by \$200,000, seconded, motion defeated 1-8-1 vote. **New motion**: Motion made to reduce article 9 to \$1,000,000, seconded, motion defeated 3-6 vote.

AdCom discussion on follow up items from previous meetings and upcoming meetings, including Marijuana and Contract Warrant Articles.

Motion made to adjourn, seconded, passed unanimously.
